# **MARCH 23, 2025**



Beloved in Christ,

Each year the first two Sundays of Lent are linked with specific events in the life of Christ: the temptations he endured in the Judean desert and the Transfiguration on the mountain, as recorded in the gospels. The Third Sunday of Lent, though, is not so much centered on an event in Christ's life, but is concerned with Jesus' teaching on the patience, mercy and love of our God. The three readings assigned for this Sunday all touch on the importance of placing our hope in God, the All Merciful and Giver of life, who is always ready to forgive our transgressions. In this Sunday's gospel passage Jesus is teaching his disciples never to give up but hope in the Father who is the God of second chance. Someone has said that we Christians speak much about God but in fact very little to God. In this Lenten season we are being called to speak to God, to be people of prayer, striving for union with our Maker, always and everywhere. Our annual observance of Lent, forty days of special prayer, fasting and almsgiving or doing good, is a golden opportunity to meet our God who satisfies the longing of our hearts. Lent is the acceptable time to return to the Lord and produce fruits in our life, the time to experience God's loving mercy and to offer our forgiveness to those who have offended us in the past or are offending us now. This is the ac-

ceptable time to be kind-hearted and give others another chance.




