





The world and everything in it are finally his. Knowing that he knows and loves us should make us also feel a deep peace at being a part of his universe. We advance his kingdom by promoting the truth. "Everyone who is of the truth hears my voice," Christ the King proclaims. In Phil's store, it was about the truth of athletics. In our world, it's all about the truth of all creation, especially the dignity of the human person, made by and for our loving God.
